January Message

New Year's Greetings to the St. Marys Methodist Church Family:

I am a terrible waiter --- I don't mean the kind that waits on your table at Hoss'. I am referring to the type of individual who lacks the skill/talent/gift, whatever you want to call it, to wait on something in life. We pondered the notion of "waiting" in our Advent study, in the adult Sunday School Class, during the month of December. We learned that the people of Israel waited 400 years for the promised Messiah to arrive. In that four centuries, "there was no prophet, no voice, no promise, and no act of God in recorded scripture." Until Jesus arrived, generations held on to the promise that that God would send a Deliverer "when the fullness of time had come." (Galatians 4:4)

Have you ever wondered how much of our lives are actually spent waiting "for something to happen?" A lot of time is spent waiting. It is a fact of life which cannot be avoided. Success in waiting makes all the difference in the quality of life we will enjoy. Most important to this subject of waiting is where does God fit into the process? We just celebrated the birth of our Savior. In the hope of Christmas, we waited for the Christ Child and in the midst of waiting for His arrival, we may have been aware of other things in life that we are waiting for. We may feel stuck in our waiting and wonder if the wait will ever end. We may think nothing is happening and we may grow weary and even want to give up. We wonder where God is and if He is ever going to do anything about the thing we are waiting for. We look for our "fullness of time."

Advent taught us to slow down and discover a faithful God Who is always there acting on our behalf, behind the scenes, moving forward with His master plan for our lives, as we wait. We were reminded of God's faithfulness in the story of Abraham and Sarah who waited 25 years from the time of the promise of Isaac to his actual birth (to parents aged 100 and 90 at the time!) That was one great wait! Jacob had to wait 14 years to marry Rachel. Joseph had to wait through many troubled years before experiencing vindication and justice in his lifetime. Mary held onto a promise for 30 years which resulted in the fulfillment that her child was, indeed, the Messiah. David waited 15 to 20 years from his anointing as King of Israel until he actually took the throne. The Bible is full of examples of God working in the lives of people who had to wait very long periods of time to see God end the time of waiting and see a promise fulfilled. So what do we do about <u>our</u> waiting? Especially when it has been a long time and we don't ever see it ending. Here are some strategies that can help in our time of waiting:

- Prayerfully ----- Psalm 25:4-5
- With strength and courage ---- Psalm 27:14, 31:24
- Rejoicing and trusting in His holy name ---- Psalm 33:21
- Based on the fear of the Lord and His unfailing love ----- Psalm 33:18,22
- With hope ---- Psalm 33:20, 39:7
- Patiently ----- Psalm 37:7, 40:1; Habakkuk 3:16, Romans 8:25, Hebrews 6:15
- Obediently ----- Psalm 37:34, 119:166; Isaiah 26:8-9
- Desiring Him ---- Isaiah 26:8-9
- Single-mindedly ----- Psalm 62:5
- Expectantly ----- Psalm 123:2, Micah 7:7
- Believing His Word ----- Psalm 130:5
- Assured He is all we need, He is our portion ---- Lamentations 3:24
- Quietly ----- Lamentations 3:26
- Always ---- Hosea 12:6
- In anticipation of joy ----- John 3:29
- Eagerly ----- Romans 8:19,23




