

April 2024 Newsletter Pastor Message – St. Marys Methodist Church

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! This month our adventure restarts with you all! We will be arriving with our RV at the pavilion on April 6th and excited for ALL that the Lord has in store for us in the coming months.

Our name "About Face" describes the heart of the ministry in two ways. It borrows from the military term of taking an "about face" and applying it to the local congregation. As we come into church, God calls us to do an "about face" and get out into the world. It also relates to the highly relational face-to-face emphasis we promote.

We will work within the church through preaching sermons that center on our call to mission/outreach/evangelism, leading Bible studies and small groups, mentoring core missional leaders, and immersing the whole church with a heart for outreach. We will also build relationships with community leaders, institutions, agencies, and social services; building bridges between the church and community to allow God to unfold opportunities for ministry outside the walls of the church. Our emphasis is on relational development rather than emergency relief ministry.

Beginning Monday, April 8th, 7:00pm, and repeated Thursday, April 11th at 9:00am we will lead a book study based upon the book, *When Helping Hurts -How to Alleviate Poverty without Hurting the Poor...and Yourself.* We will learn about brokenness in the world, our community, and our very own selves; and God's restoration and healing for ALL that are poor in spirit. This gathering will meet for six weeks. We hope you choose to avail yourself to this teaching opportunity! (You are not required to have the book; however, it will enhance your growth. We will have copies for sale when we get there.)

Isaiah 52:7 proclaims, "How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!" Prepare your hearts, minds and feet to be beautiful proclaimers of the good news of Jesus Christ to our St. Marys community. See you soon!
