### THOUGHTS ON HOPE .. PART 2

According to the New Testament the mood of the disciples on the eve of the resurrection was one of shocked disbelief and bitter disappointment. At first, they could not bring themselves to believe that it had all ended this way. God had let them down. Then an utterly unbelievable thing happened. Early in the morning on the first day of the week they discovered the empty tomb, and before the day was over, they knew that Jesus was alive! Refusing to trust their own senses at first, Peter and John ran to see the tomb for themselves. Thomas would not believe until he had an opportunity to touch Jesus. But before long they all knew that it was incredibly true. Their Lord had risen from the dead!

At the center of John's gospel, precisely at the turning point between the two major sections, Jesus reveals a vital part of the inner meaning of this resurrection event. "The hour has come for the Son of Man to be glorified," he said. "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but only if it dies, it bears much fruit" (12:23-24). The immediate intent of this statement is obvious, though the disciples missed it at the time. Jesus is saying he has his own death of wheat to face on the cross. He must die if there is to be new growth, so he must die in order to become the risen and triumphant Lord.

But this same principle is telling us something vital about our own lives and about the possibility of living with hope on every level of our existence. The loving God who reveals his presence through Jesus Christ is a God of resurrection power. Everywhere and at all times he is acting through a process of death and resurrection to give us new wholeness of life. He is always working to transform death into life, sickness into health, sorrow into joy, and despair into hope. As I experience this resurrection process at work within me and around me, I can identify with it and move into the future with expectation. This applies to my daily dying, to the death of my physical body and to the dying institutions and structures in the world around me.
