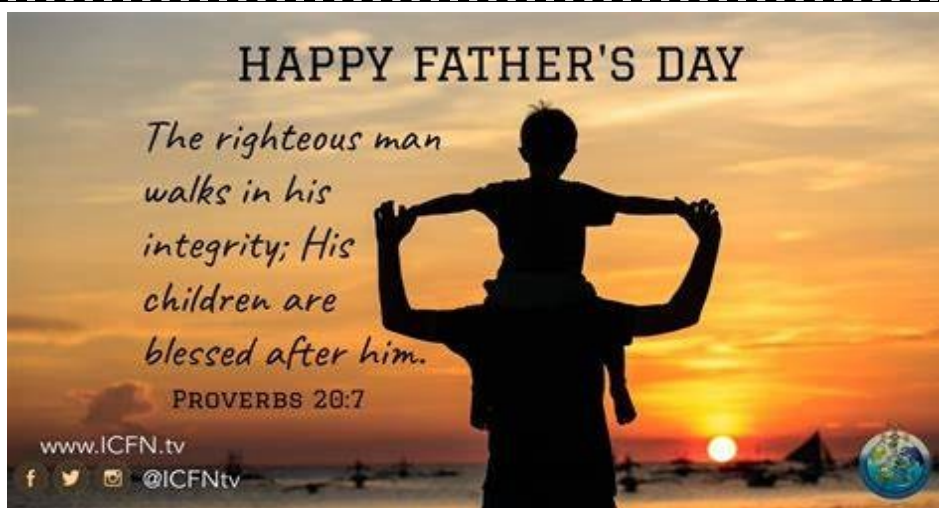

June Message

From the Pastor's Study

In the daily process of trying to live a Christian life, we sometimes encounter unexpected emotional bumps and bruises. Like cutting your finger, an emotional bruise can become infected and develop into painful situations if not taken care of. Every person needs some knowledge of first aid, both physical and emotional.

Use the following 8 steps to heal your emotional injuries before they become infected:

1. Talk out your experience with your Pastor.
2. Remind yourself that ALL EXPERIENCE IS TEMPORARY, especially when things seem to be going against you.
3. Circumstances can be changed by your own THOUGHTS.
4. When some person chooses a course of action of which you disapprove, remind yourself that he is looking at things from his point of view, not yours.
5. Mentally meet your responsibilities ONE at a time.
6. Laugh heartily at least three times a day.
7. If you feel impatient ask yourself, WHAT WILL THIS MATTER TO YOU ONE YEAR FROM NOW.
8. Say, "I bless you" for every person who comes to your mind.

Pray for Nigeria: Our Bishops Call to Compassion and Support

On May 23, 2025, the village of Munga Lelau in Taraba State, Nigeria—part of the Northeast Annual Conference of the Global Methodist Church—was brutally attacked by members of the Fulani militia, an extremist group. Forty-two innocent lives were lost, including women, children, and church members. Dozens of homes were destroyed, and survivors—many of them women and children—are now displaced without food, shelter, or medical care.

Bishop John Pena Auta shares, “We are mobilizing our churches to respond, but we are overwhelmed by the scale of this tragedy.” The Church is urged to act swiftly and prayerfully.
