FREEDOM

For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery." – Galatians 5:1

As we gather around picnics, fireworks, and parades this Independence Day, we give thanks for the freedoms we enjoy as citizens of this great nation. We celebrate the courage of those who fought for liberty and the enduring vision of a people determined to live free. Our national freedom is a gift—hard-won, deeply cherished, and worth protecting. But as believers, we know there is a deeper freedom that shapes our lives: the freedom we have in Jesus Christ.

Paul writes in Galatians 5:1, "For freedom Christ has set us free; stand firm therefore, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery." This is not the kind of freedom that simply releases us from oppression or external control. It is a freedom that breaks the chains of sin, sets our hearts free from guilt and shame, and invites us into the abundant life of grace. It is not a freedom to do whatever we please, but the freedom to live fully as God intends—with love, purpose, and service.

As Christians living in a free country, we have a double blessing—and a double responsibility. On the one hand, we should use our freedom to pray for our nation, participate in its life, and help it become more just, more compassionate, and more faithful to its ideals. On the other hand, we are called to use our spiritual freedom to build up the Kingdom of God. That means serving others, sharing the good news, and letting our lives be a testimony to the transforming power of Christ.

So this Fourth of July, wave your flags, light your sparklers, and give thanks. But don't stop there. Let your celebration also be a recommitment—to stand firm in Christ's freedom and to use that liberty to bless both our nation and God's Kingdom. In doing so, we honor the sacrifices of those who came before us and live as faithful stewards of the freedom Christ has given.


